

Zero Deforestation Policy

Purpose

Yesiang recognizes forests as critical assets of the global ecosystem, essential for climate regulation, biodiversity conservation, and human well-being. In response to international sustainability trends, the Company is firmly committed to achieving “No Gross Deforestation” to ensure that its operations and supply chain activities do not contribute to forest destruction or habitat loss.

Policy Commitments

- **Zero Deforestation Principle**

Effective immediately, all procurement, production, and development activities for Yesiang’s products and raw materials shall avoid any involvement in High Conservation Value Forests (HCVF), High Carbon Stock Forests (HCSF), or peatland development. The Company’s sustainable procurement and supply chain management require all suppliers to comply with the zero-deforestation principle, which is incorporated into supplier contracts and evaluation mechanisms. Yesiang prioritizes the purchase of internationally certified products (e.g., FSC, PEFC, RSPO) and has established traceability mechanisms to ensure the transparency and accountability of raw material sourcing. In addition, Yesiang actively supports habitat restoration, reforestation, and community-based forest protection programs. The Company collaborates with governments, non-governmental organizations (NGOs), academic institutions, and industry partners to promote sustainable forest management and to create shared environmental and social value.

Scope of Application

This policy applies to Yesiang and all its subsidiaries and business units, and extends to its supply chain and business partners.

Continuous Improvement

As international standards and market expectations evolve, Yesiang will regularly review and update this policy to continuously strengthen its commitment and implementation toward zero deforestation.
